Mladen Vinković was born on 11 February 1966 in Zagreb. He completed primary education in Zagreb in 1980, and in 1984 he graduated from the Secondary Technical School "Nikola Tesla". He graduated in May 1992 from the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture in Zagreb and acquired the title of Graduate Mechanical Engineer. From 1992 till 1993 he worked at the Sesvete Secondary School as a teacher teaching a group of mechanical engineering subjects. In 1993 he was employed at the Department for Firefighting of the Zagreb Police as a fire station commander in the City of Zagreb. During his service at the Department for Firefighting he was a shift commander of the firefighting unit and a firefighting unit commander. From 1995 to 1997 he went to work in the private sector as a Production Director at the "Klanjčić d.o.o." Company. In 1997 he started to work at the Ministry of the Interior, Department for Firefighting as an operating employee for tactics and technology. He has remained in the firefighting activities until today as an assistant to the chief firefighting commander of the Republic of Croatia.

During his service in firefighting (Ministry of the Interior and National Protection and Rescue Directorate - NPRD) he completed a number of courses of the European Civil Protection Training, and other international courses, courses of rescue from the depths and the heights and courses of rescue from the rubble also abroad.

He has been active in studying and improving the rescue skills in firefighting, preparing the education programs, and more recently he has been involved in the research in the field of leadership and commanding during firefighting interventions as well as in applying Incident Command System (ICS) in management during major accidents. He was the initiator of using new technologies in firefighting such as unmanned aviation systems as support in managing interventions. He is one of seven authors of the book "Fundamentals of Wildfire Fighting" published in 2010 in Zagreb. He is a lecturer at the University of Applied Sciences Velika Gorica conducting the subject "Topography and GIS". At the National Protection and Rescue Directorate he is a lecturer of various specialist upgrade subjects.
